- 6. Passing marks required 40%....ie 20 right answers should be there
- 7. There shall be no negative marking
- 8. Maximum time given to attempt 1 question shall be 15 seconds

Detailed Instruction to Attempt Examination

We have successfully completed the process of conducting online examination. Now it is time to follow the instruction here are they;

- 1. After one attempt you will not be able to edit your responses in the online test. So students are advised to Mark their response was very carefully.
- 2. The online test shall be available to individual for up to 3 hours. Once login then have to complete the test. You have choices of login time as per your convenience between those three hours. It is suggested to login as soon as possible.

- 3. Only 20 seconds time is scheduled to answer a particular question. After that if you mark response, and then no marks will be allotted to him/her as per the software settings.
- 4. After every 10 question you will be given the option to remark one wrong question.
- 5. Students are advised to attempt the whole quiz in one go, otherwise you shall not be another chance to login again. In that case student shall be declared as fail.
- 6. Students are advised not to run any application along with the test. Running application may fetch more data and you may not be able to complete it.
- 7. One should not use the pause or restart button in between the test. This may also force you to logout from the application.
